## Antiquarian Bookhunting in Charlottesville

CHARLOTTESVILLE, VIRGINIA, is a pretty town of about 40,000 people located at the center of Albemarle County in the Virginia Piedmont, about a two hours' drive from Washington, DC. Long celebrated as the location of Thomas Jefferson's home, Monticello, and of his University of Virginia (UVa), Charlottesville has in recent years become a flourishing center for antiquarian books, with more used and rare bookshops than any other city in Virginia.

Located at the University, Rare Book School (RBS) sponsors frequent five-day institutes, offering a variety of non-credit courses on the history of books and printing. The UVa Library and RBS maintain an active schedule of free rare book exhibitions both in the Albert and Shirley Small Special Collections Library, and also in the Rotunda, centerpiece of one of the most beautiful academic settings in the United States.

In addition to its used and antiquarian bookstores, the area is noted for its specialty shops, including antiques, oriental rugs, pewter, and handmade quilts; and there are many excellent local restaurants and hotels at all price ranges.

Charlottesville is located on Interstate 64 between I-81 and I-95, in a landscape of great scenic beauty and historical interest. It is an attractive destination for a day trip or weekend expedition.

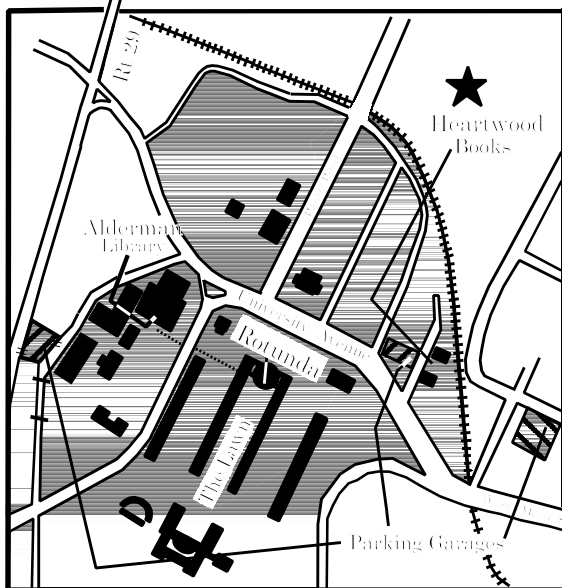

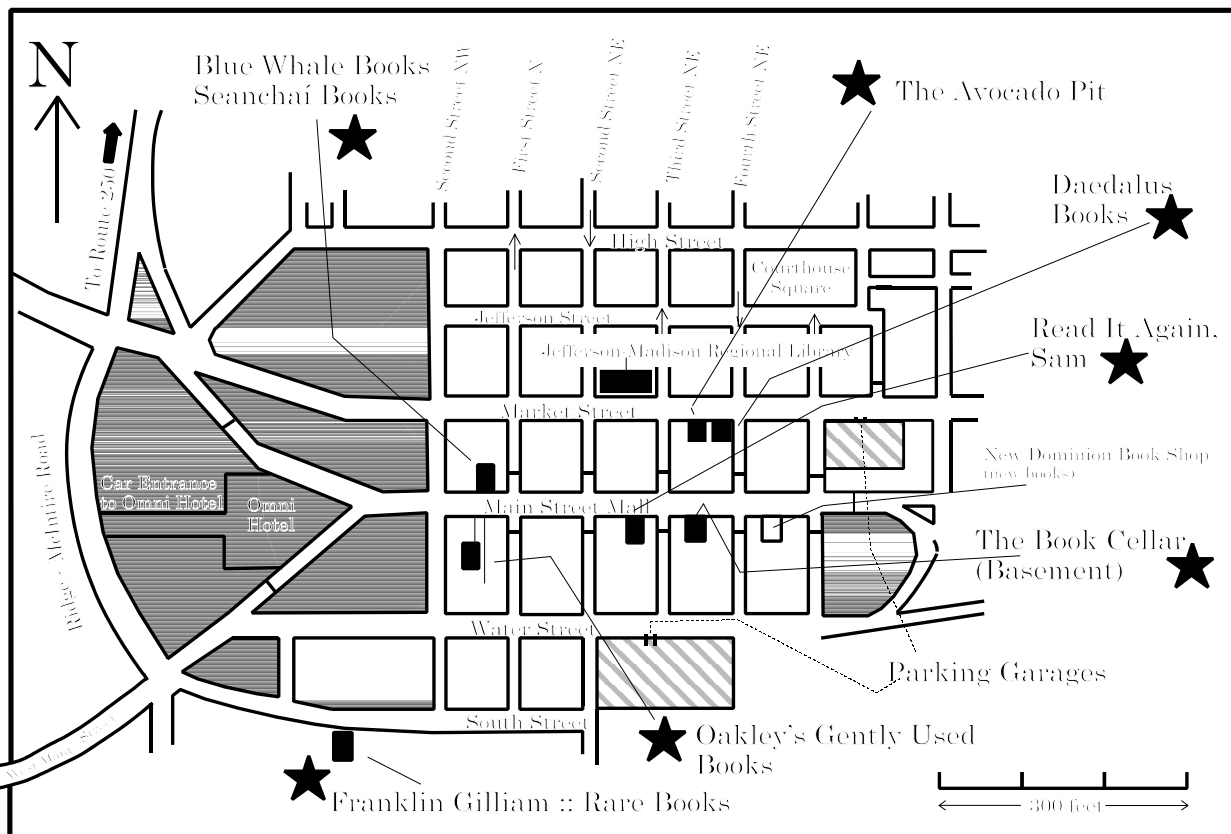
